# Serving Our City

## Centered on Jesus, Serving our City.

We are committed to serving our city in meaningful and practical ways, sharing the hope and love of Jesus with those who need it most. In 2025, we partnered with organizations like Hope Reins to care for children healing from trauma, and Christian Life Home to support young women facing crisis pregnancies. Through collaborations with Dorcas Ministries and Tri-Area Food Pantry, we helped provide essential food and resources to families in need. Additionally, alongside Raleigh Dream Center, we served our neighbors through outreach initiatives, bringing hope and restoration to those experiencing homelessness and addiction.

# From Our City to the Nations

*The Great Commission expands our vision beyond our city—calling us to reach our neighbors and the nations with the gospel of Jesus Christ.*

## Missions of Hope International - \$6,000

We officially began a partnership with Missions of Hope International, an organization bringing life change to children & families in Kenya. We've partnered by sponsoring 340 children at one of the schools in Joska, Kenya.

## Rapha International - \$6,000

DCC supported Rapha's mission to combat the trafficking and sexual abuse of children - one child, one family, and one community at a time. They operate survivor care, prevention services, and support programs in Cambodia, Thailand, Haiti, and the United States.

## Second Chance Children's Ministry - \$5,000

We also helped SCCM reach forgotten orphans in Uganda. They provide orphan children with the opportunity to get an education and learn life skills, teaching them their true identity in Jesus Christ.
